The earliest mention of the Manor House in Radonie dates back to the end of the XVIII century. In the mid XIX century, Piotr Folkierski, of the House of Radwan, built a brick, classical style manor house, based on a traditional rectangular shape, on the outskirts of Warsaw. In the same period, a beautiful, scenic park was created on the grounds of the manor house. After World War II the Radonie Manor shared the fate of many Polish manor houses, it was taken over by the State and fell into disrepair and ruin. In 2010, after nine years of painstaking restoration, the Manor House, was returned to its former glory. The new owners have decided that they would like to share its beauty and make it available for exceptional events.

Kitchen


The roomy kitchen, adjacent to the dining room, is the prefect space for preparing exquisite meals.

We engage internationally acclaimed musical performers, including both foreign and Polish classical music soloists. At your request, we can prepare a bespoke musical programme, to complement your meeting.




The owners of the Manor House in Radonie took many years to restore it to its former glory and create a place which is, first and foremost, their family home.
